SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF REPORT ON DELINQUENT REAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR 2021

BACKGROUND

North Carolina General Statute 105-369 requires the Tax Administrator to report unpaid taxes for the current fiscal year that are liens on real property by the first Monday in February. The purpose of the reporting is to allow you to order the Tax Administrator to advertise the tax liens. Upon receipt of your order, I will advertise the tax liens by posting notice at the County Courthouse and by publishing each lien at least one time in one or more of the newspapers having general circulation in Cumberland County.

The statute requires the advertisement period for unpaid taxes that are liens on real property to occur during the period of March 1st through June 30th. It is my intention to deliver a list of delinquent taxes to the Fayetteville Observer newspaper prior to June 30th for advertisement.

\$19,162,868 on 18,837 parcels as of 1/25/2022

RECOMMENDATION / PROPOSED ACTION

Accept the report of unpaid taxes for the current fiscal year that are liens on real property and charge the Tax Administrator to advertise a list of the tax liens on real property by posting notice at the County Courthouse and by publishing each lien at least one time in the Fayetteville Observer no later than the month of June 2022.
